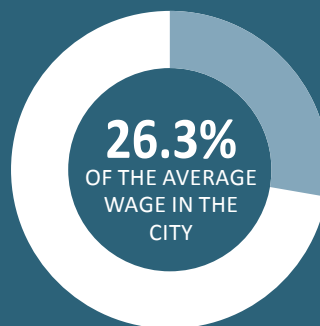

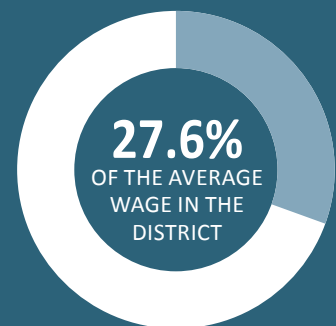

COST OF RENTING

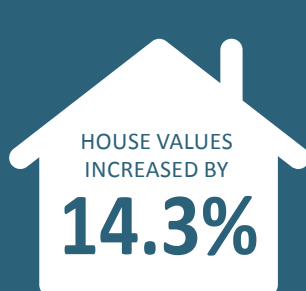

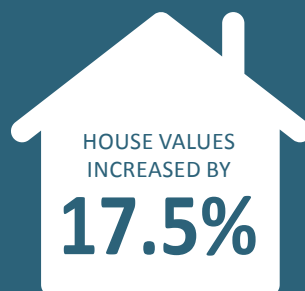

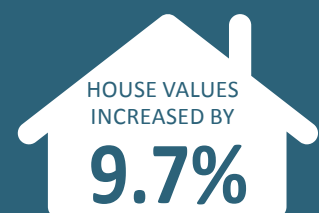
HOUSE VALUES (YEAR ENDING MAY 2017)**
