TOURISM

Guest nights are down considerably compared to the national trend. However, this is expected coming off a very strong few years. Fewer events and businesses cutting costs are likely contributors.

Although visitor spend is slightly down, the region continues to benefit from tourism, but like the rest of the country, is being affected by the pullback in spending.
